



Gift Card Terms and Conditions

1. The Gift Card is issued by Largs Chandlers Ltd and is available in store or by telephone.
2. The Gift Card can have a cash value added to it (minimum £5) which can be used to pay for goods and services from Largs Chandlers, including account payments. You can use the whole or part of your balance in a transaction with any remaining balance available for use in the future. You can also add to the balance on your card. The maximum balance on a card is £250.
3. The card may only be used to pay for items instore. It cannot be used for telephone purchases.
4. The balance on your card cannot be exchanged for cash or refunded.
5. Should your card be lost or stolen we may be able to replace it provided that it is registered in your name and you can prove your identity. We are not responsible for any unauthorised use up until the time you notify us of its loss.
6. We reserve the right to refuse to accept a gift card if we suspect that it has been duplicated or tampered with. We may also refuse to accept a card if we believe that it is being used fraudulently or without authorisation.
7. Your card will expire after 36 months of inactivity. At this point any remaining balance will be removed and the card will become invalid.
8. Money added to the card is a prepayment for such goods or service and is not a credit service or deposit account. No interest will accrue on the balance remaining on your card.
9. We will retain your information only as necessary to provide the service to you or as to comply with our legal obligations. You can find our full privacy policy on our website.
10. These terms and conditions represent the whole of agreement between you and Largs Chandlers with regards the use of the gift card and supersedes any prior agreement wither orally or in writing. We reserve the right to change these terms and conditions from time to time. Any updates will be posted on our website and should you not agree to the new terms and conditions you may request that the balance be refunded to you. These terms and conditions will be governed by Scottish law and justiciable in the Scottish Courts.
